## **Making Commands in Arabic**

Making commands is so easy! Here's how to do it:

1. Make the present tense of the verb:------ يَكْتُب / يَدَرِّس

2. Delete the first syllable (ڍَ) ------ کُتُب / دَرِّس

3. If there is a vowel on the first letter, congrats! That's the command.----- كَرُّس If there is a sukuun (ໍ) on the first letter, you need to do one more step.

\*But how do I know if it's اكتُب (uktub) or اكتُب (iktub) or اكتُب \*But how do I know if it's الكثب

- Look at the first vowel after the alif.
  - If it is damma ('"u"), the alif gets a damma (')
  - If it is kesra (oʻ "i") or fatha (oʻ "a"), the alif gets a kesra (o)
  - If it is a form IV verb, the alif gets a fatha (6 "a") on a hamza (5), which will look like: (1)

Here are some more examples:

- (I) Play 🗖 يُلْعَب 🗖 لُعَب 🗖 لِلْعَب 🗖 الْعَب
- (II) Repair 🗖 يُصَلِّح 🗖 🗖
- (III) Try □ يُحاول □ يُحاول ✓
- (IV) Submit 🗖 سُلِم 🗖 سُلِم 🕳 سُلِم 🕳 پُسْلِم \*Form IV verb commands always start with
- (V) Interfere 🗖 يَتَدَخَّل 🗖 يَتَدَخَّل 🗖
- (VI) Deal with ☐ تَعامَل مَعَ ☐ يَتَعامَل مَعَ
- (X) Work ☐ يَشْتَغِل ☐ يَشْتَغِل ☐

To tell different people to do something, you just add one of these endings on the command:

- You male singular أَنتً : keep as is (you write: الْكتُب
- You female singular ي add ي to the end (you write: اُكتُبي)
- You plural وا add وا (pronounced "oo") to the end (you all write: الْتُمُرانتوا
